# Immunisation (Nurse Immuniser)

**This course has been accredited by Health Education Services Australia as meeting the National Standards of Immunisation Education for Registered Nurses. Registered Nurses who successfully complete this course are approved to administer specified vaccines and manage adverse reactions where there may not be a medical practitioner present.**

National accreditation does not mean that all states will give mutual recognition. Nurses outside of Victoria should check course recognition with their local health authority. This program of study will focus on the theory and practical components of adult and childhood immunisations and includes:

- An overview of public health and the National Immunisation Program
- Clinical issues relevant to nurses administering immunisations
- Vaccines included in the National Immunisation Program and vaccine catch-up
- The storage and handling of vaccines including cold chain management
- The regulatory requirements relating to the administration of vaccines by registered nurses.
