## Professor Kenneth Rockwood

### "Managing frailty starts with naming it"



Professor Kenneth Rockwood is a professor of medicine (geriatric medicine and neurology) at Dalhousie University, Canada and an active staff physician at the Queen Elizabeth II Health Sciences Centre. He is also the Kathryn Allen Weldon Professor of Alzheimer Research at Dalhousie University and Senior Medical Director for Acute Care for the province of Nova Scotia.

A leading authority on frailty, Prof Rockwood has more than 450 peer-reviewed publications and nine books to his credit, including the eighth edition of the Brocklehurst's Textbook of Geriatric Medicine & Gerontology. He is Associate Director of the Canadian Collaboration Canadian Collaboration on Neurodegeneration in Aging, and leads its Quality of Life theme, and Knowledge Translation platform.
