Available until July 2027.	<p>Time spent with practice nurses can be counted towards the total time taken for the health assessment (695). Assistance must be in accordance with accepted GP/PMP and under the supervision of the GP/PMP. This may include activities such as information collection and providing information about recommended interventions.</p> <p>The GP is expected to take a primary role in the following activities when providing a health assessment:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • reviewing and analysing the information collected; • making an overall assessment of the patient; • undertaking and arranging investigations and referrals for identified abnormalities; • generating a preventative health plan; and • providing advice to the patient. <p>GPs should not use the delegation of tasks to practice nurses to extend the time that could reasonably be claimed given the patient's presentation and the type of assessment undertaken.</p> <p>Performed STI screen + health assessment = 23 + 695.</p>

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Consider the time limits and ensure that the total consultation duration reflects the combined time for both item numbers. Example: 4001 + 23 = minimum 26 minutes or 4001 + 36 = minimum 40 minutes
