Recycling Stations

Installed in 2023, the Mercy Recycling Stations allow us to easily dispose of hard-to-recycle items (think coffee pods, medication vial lids, batteries and small e-waste, such as cables and headphones).

We have one located right near the lifts and bathrooms on Level 4, just before you turn towards our offices.

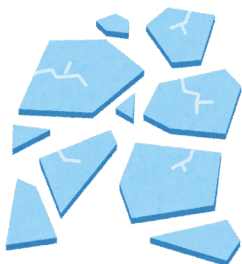


Rigid Plastic & Cans

Place in recycling bins located near the printers

Soft Plastics

Unfortunately, we do not yet have a way to recycle soft plastics, so this will need to go in landfill. Try to avoid where possible



Glass

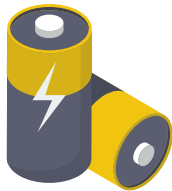
Place bottles and jars in recycling. However, broken glass needs to be wrapped in paper and put in landfill

Blister Packs

Deposit in blister pack recycling box at Level 4 reception desk



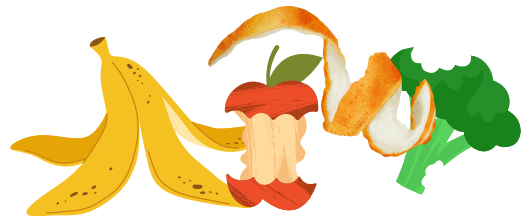
Cardboard & Paper

Use paper recycling bins located near printers, as well as kitchen



Kitchen Waste

Consider taking your food waste or scraps home, adding them to your home compost bin



Ice or Gel Packs

Deposit in icepack recycling box at Level 4 reception desk for others to repurpose



Bubble Wrap

Deposit in bubble wrap recycling box at Level 4 reception desk
