2022 Travel Scholarship



Applications are being accepted for the inaugural Department of Critical Care Travel Scholarship. The Department will contribute \$1000 to the travel costs of the successful applicant to attend a scientific meeting in 2022.

The successful applicant will be informed by COB Friday 28 January 2022.

Eligibility Criteria

- Higher degree research student enrolled with the Department of Critical Care
- The conference must be a national level conference being held within the 2022 calendar year
- The student must **not** have a hospital appointment at a consultant specialist level (i.e. the student has no access to CME support)
- The student must be presenting (with preference for an oral presentation but poster presentation is acceptable)
- As of 28 February 2022, the student should not have submitted their thesis for examination.

Preparing your application

Applications should be no more than 250 words and include the following sub-headings:

- The proposed meeting
- The title of the student's presentation
- The proposed benefit of this presentation for the student
- Student's anticipated date for submitting their thesis.

Ranking

Applications will be ranked according to:

- Preference given for oral presentation
- Preference for those who plan on submitting their thesis prior to December 2023
- Outputs of the applicant in the last two years.
