



Medical Termination of Pregnancy (MTOp)

HELPFUL INFORMATION FOR ADMINISTRATION TEAM:

TIMEFRAME

At Gateway Health, we can provide MTOp up to 9 weeks of pregnancy

If > 9 weeks, the client is ineligible for MTOp, please arrange appointment with Sexual Health Nurse for discussion

If the client is very close to 9 weeks, the Sexual Health Nurse is happy to discuss the possibility of a prompt appointment

GATEWAY HEALTH PROCESS

Please inform all clients that they require x2 Appointments- this is **NOT** negotiable

First Appointment:

Admin to book 45 minute appointment with Clinic 35 and "Consult for Nurse" with Dr Orr

NB: If Dr Orr not available, double book "Consult for Nurse" appointment with any other GP

Second Appointment:

Sexual Health Nurse will organise second appointment for scripts and discuss follow up

TESTS THE CLIENT MAY HAVE PRIOR WITH OWN GP (Please note NOT compulsory):

- Blood tests:
 - Pregnancy blood test: Quantitative BHCG
 - Blood group and Antibodies
 - Full blood count
 - Iron Studies

- Pelvic Ultrasound to confirm intrauterine pregnancy (**Note: NOT a dating scan**)
