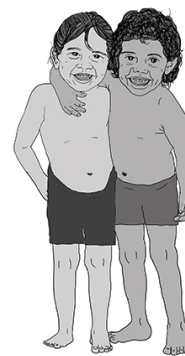

The **Ages and Stages Questionnaires®**, **Third Edition (ASQ-3™)** is a parent-completed child monitoring system.

As part of the TRAK study, the ASQ-3™ was culturally adapted for use in Australian Aboriginal communities. The TRAK study was undertaken at Menzies School of Health Research in the Northern Territory, Australia, with support from the Lowitja Institute. The **ASQ-TRAK** is the adapted ASQ-3™.

The **ASQ-TRAK Questionnaires** have been designed to be used in conjunction with the **ASQ-TRAK Flip Chart**. The ASQ-TRAK Questionnaires are administered by interview while the parents and caregivers view the ASQ-TRAK Flip Chart.

ASQ-TRAK questionnaire intervals are 2, 6, 12, 18, 24, 36 and 48 months of age.
