Dear

This client has attended a consultation with Dr.....at Gateway Health, Wodonga, and has consented to the treatment of Mifepristone Linepharma (Mifepristone) and GyMiso® (Misoprostol) for the termination of early pregnancy under 63 days gestation.

As per the MS-2 Step™ process, Drhas prescribed Mifepristone 200mg taken atPharmacy, Albury, and Misoprostol 800mcg taken at home 36-48 hours later.

The patient is **Rh Positive**. See results attached.

It should be noted that the risks of medical termination of pregnancy are similar to natural miscarriage and the medical management remains the same. Please note if an early ultrasound is performed, retained products of conception will be present, and clients can experience prolonged bleeding up until their next menstrual period.

Clients can access 24 hour telephone support through MS Health, who will assist in their decision to present to the Emergency Department. As recommended by MS Health, the indications for a presentation to the Emergency Department are: heavy vaginal bleeding, this is described as soaking two or more sanitary pads per hour for more than 2 consecutive hours, or large clots; prolonged cramping and pain which is unrelieved by medication or non-pharmacological methods such as heat packs; abnormal vaginal discharge; feeling unwell for more than 24 hours, this includes fever, weakness, fatigue, nausea, vomiting, diarrhoea and abdominal pain

For continuation of care, we are happy to follow up this client once discharged and upon receiving a discharge summary.
