The Degree of Doctor of Medicine with distinction will be awarded within the Faculty of Medicine, Dentistry and Health Sciences as detailed hereunder:

The MD with distinction degree will be offered to those whose overall weighted score is 80% or greater.

DOCTOR OF MEDICINE DEAN'S HONOURS LIST

Purpose

On the recommendation of the University, the Faculty of Medicine, Dentistry and Health Sciences approved the establishment of a Dean's Honours List from 1993 to give formal recognition to the achievements of its most outstanding students. The list comprises a small number of students of high distinction at each year level of the medical course.

Procedure

A ranked list will be prepared by the relevant course coordinator for each year level based on weighted aggregate results for that year level. Subjects with a 'PASS/FAIL' assessment will be excluded from the aggregate calculation.

The course coordinator will:

- prepare a ranked list for each MD year level indicating the top 5% which will be awarded Dean's Honours
- prepare letters of congratulations to all recipients to be signed by the Head of the School
- send the recipients details to the Academic Records Office, Student Administration for noting on each student's transcript.
