## What is Future Health Today?

FHT uses patient records to automate the identification of patients who:



- are **at risk** of chronic disease;
- have a chronic disease but **no recorded diagnosis**; or,
- are **living with chronic disease** and may benefit from optimised management.

FHT provides:



- **clinical decision support** to optimise appropriate testing, diagnosis, treatment and management;



- **guideline concordant care recommendations** relating to the identification and management of chronic diseases;



- **potential economic benefits** via identification of patients who may be eligible for GP Management Plans and Health Assessments; and,



- **quality improvement, education and capacity building opportunities**
